Product Description: Kritik is a peer assessment application used by educational institutions to enhance learning through peer review and feedback. It allows students to evaluate each other's work and provides instructors with tools to manage and assess these peer assessments effectively. Kritik is designed to improve student engagement, encourage critical thinking, and foster a collaborative learning environment.

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Evaluation Methods Used

The accessibility assessment was conducted according to the following steps:

- I. Tested using Chrome Version 107.0.5304.110 (Official Build) (arm64) on macOS Monterey Version 12.5. Used IBM Accessibility Checker plugin to test all software and website pages against WCAG 2.1 Accessibility Criteria
- II. Manually checked website and software against WCAG 2.1 Accessibility Criteria using Chrome Version 107.0.5304.110 (Official Build) (arm64) on macOS Monterey Version 12.5.
