Product Description: Kritik is a web-based application that allows students to evaluate their peers and give/receive feedback from one another. Students can respond from their laptop, mobile, and tablet using a web browser.

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Evaluation Methods Used

The accessibility assessment was conducted according to the following steps:

- I. Tested using Chrome Version 115.0.5790.170/171 (Official Build) (arm64) on macOS Version 13.4.1 (c). Used IBM Accessibility Checker plugin to test all software pages against WCAG 2.1 Accessibility Criteria
